The Feast of St. Brigid Friday, 1st February, 2019

St. Brigid is the secondary patron saint of Ireland and was renowned for her hospitality, almsgiving and care of the sick.



Brigid was born c454. When she was young, her father wanted to make a suitable marriage for her, but she insisted in consecrating her life to God. She received the veil and spiritual formation. probably from St. Mel, and stayed for a period under his direction in Ardagh. Others followed her example and this led her to found a double monastery in Kildare with the assistance of Bishop Conleth.

Brigid died in 524 and the St. Brigid's Cross, in legend used by Brigid to explain the Christian faith, remains a popular sign of God's protection.
