EXPERIENCING GOD'S FRIENDSHIP

Social media enables us to know a great deal about other people almost instantly at the click of a button without ever meeting or knowing them personally. Actually, Google can do something similar for us about Jesus, about his life story as well as about his teachings. Valuable though such knowledge is, it will never blossom into fulfilling and enriching friendship without an actual experience of God.

In today's Readings, we meet three people who experienced God directly in ways that changed their whole lives. Sensing the majesty of God, **ISAIAH** was prepared to let God's power act in him so that he became his messenger to the whole world of his time. Miraculously converted on the road to Damascus, **PAUL** was so captivated by this experience of Jesus that nothing ever mattered to him ever again except to preach Christ crucified. On the other hand, **PETER** experienced Christ in miracles in the routine of daily living. He responded as best he could and gradually let the love of Jesus take him over.

God touches our lives in less spectacular ways. We may not even notice, but unless we attend to his presence, we will settle for routine religion without ever letting God mould us as he did to Isaiah, Paul and Peter.

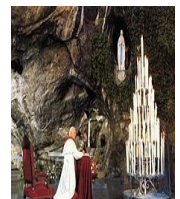
Heart Throbs - Cardiac Support Group:
