Night train - the extraordinary world of bird migration

Tom Kelly retired as a lecturer in Zoology at UCC in 2012 - but continues to teach and to do research. Most of the latter focuses on birds, which have been a major interest since childhood.

Tom's presentation will address selected aspects of the biology and behaviour of birds. In addition to Migration, the talk will consider aspects of bird flight, breeding biology, the impact of climate change and how the bird fauna of Ireland has changed over time.

The presentation will also look at how birds interact with humanity at large - both negatively and positively - and how science has responded by developing interesting management techniques and pioneering ideas about Conservation.

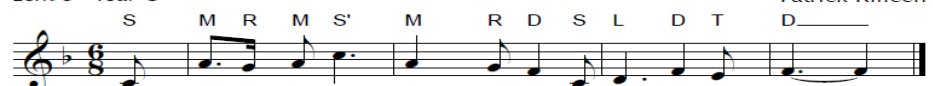
