In Court the best witness is often quite objective and is not personally involved in the outcome of the case. It was quite different when Jesus sends disciples out as witnesses to his life, his message and resurrection. He sends them into a world more searching and dismissive than any court or tribunal. But the original disciples were not to be merely reliable reporters of the past, but were to be people whose lives were radically enriched by the message they were recounting.

It is such committed witnesses that our rapidly changing world and church needs today. A heresy of our time is neutrality about values. Jesus was far from neutral about the sacredness of life, about truth, justice, forgiveness, generosity and love. Neither can his followers, his witnesses, today be neutral. Each one, alone and together, is promised power from on high to enable us to be wise and courageous witnesses to the Gospel by how we live and how we speak.
