## WELCOME TO BISHOP FINTAN



The new Bishop of our diocese will be ordained in the North Cathedral on today, Sunday, 30th June, 2019. The 3.00pm ceremony at the Cathedral will be televised live on the website of the diocese [www.corkandross.org](http://www.corkandross.org). Mass will be concelebrated by the Apostolic Nuncio, most of the Bishops of Ireland, the Priests of our diocese as well as Priests from Fr. Fintan's home diocese of Dublin. There will also be Priests from abroad. Bishop John Buckley will be the principal consecrating Bishop at the Ordination Ceremony. All the seating at the Cathedral is already assigned but Fr. Fintan invites all the people from across the diocese, wherever they may be to join with him in prayer on this Sunday afternoon.
