The political backroom personnel are striving urgently to rectify their situation before the next General Election, but the endeavor needs the creative enthusiasm of all who believe in their party's policies.

Is there any parallel for us on this Pentecost Day, the birthday of our Church?

Certainly, the young, and not so young, are haemorrhaging from among us. Many of them are not experiencing our powerful message of God's enriching love and healing forgiveness as relevant in our rapidly changing technological modern world. Is our present packaging of the message life-giving? Are we living out the message so fully ourselves as to convince others to adopt our lifestyle?

Pentecost Day is a reassuring and challenging clarion call to action before a generation is lost. The reassurance is that the same Spirit that transformed the shattered frightened disciples into confident witnesses to the Resurrection of Jesus is with us too. The challenge is to be courageously creative together. Will I open my heart to allow the Spirit come upon me to enable me to enrich the communities among whom I live? Will we talk of Jesus to anyone of the young cohort this week? Will we encourage and affirm goodness and truth? Will we show as much interest in our children's religious formation as we do in their mathematical education? Will we allow Pentecost to disturb our complacency as it fills us with joy?
