A NEW BEGINNING - A LOCAL PENTECOST

On Wednesday next, 25th September, Feast day of St. Finbarr, Bishop Fintan gathers the Priests of this Diocese together in prayer to reflect on the blessings God pours out on his people through the Church in Cork in 2019, a time of enormous opportunities and daunting challenges.

This current gathering reminds me of how the disciples of two thousand years ago joined Mary in prayer in the Upper Room in Jerusalem. Just then they were a cowed and frightened group. They had experienced the crest of

a wave in popularity as friends of Jesus at Cana, Nain, Capernaum and even in Jerusalem itself on Palm Sunday before the devastation of Calvary. Now, even with the glimpse of Resurrection to encourage them, they were losing hope, unsure of how God was now calling them.

Then it happened. The Holy Spirit came upon them. A new creative power of God was released among them. What a gift.

Such a gift can be ours if we ask for it in fervent prayer. Just as the early disciples joined in prayer with Mary, we can join her through the Rosary as well as through the Eucharist especially. In our religious tradition, key moments (like Easter) were often preceded by vigil prayer the night before, so you may like to join in vigil prayer of intercession on this *Tuesday night (24th September) at 8.00pm* for an hour or however long you may like to stay here in the Church of the Descent of the Holy Spirit. You may join in spirit in your own home.
