MADE FOR SERVICE

Dr. Tony Holohan's return to leadership in public service gave a confidence boost to many anxious people who had come to trust his competence, his commitment, his honesty and his courage.

Trusted leadership is an enriching gift to every family and community. It binds us together in our shared attitude towards the opportunities and difficulties of each day. It inspires an appreciation of wisdom and of practical guidelines to better living. It moves our hearts from resentment regarding restrictions ,to gratitude for signposts to safety and well being. It helps each of us to recognise an increasing personal responsibility for one another's welfare. Such leadership is a treasure beyond compare.
