Mark 10: 17-27

What Must I do, Lord.

It was a simple direct question from a wealthy young man of goodwill, anxious to support the Lord's campaign of preaching the Good News. The problem arose when the questioner was unwilling or unable to take the Lord's answer on board and live out its inbuilt challenge. Jesus had seized the opportunity to invite the young man to greater friendship and intimacy with Himself, but the young heir found the cost too high and went away sad. He had kept the commandments faithfully always and maybe he was only looking for reassurance that he was doing fine rather than seeking the Lord's guidance.
