So that all may be heard - Synodal Pathway May 2022

It's not every day that the Holy Father asks every Catholic in the world to have a say in the life of the Catholic Church!

During this month of May, the Diocese of Cork and Ross is opening up ways for people to have a say and to listen and have an input into next year's Synod meeting in Rome which is called by Pope Francis.

The easiest way to find out more and to have your say is to go to synod.corkandross.org where an online confidential questionnaire is available to be filled in. (It'll take about 15 minutes.)

It's open until May 24th. All the responses will be collated and added to the feedback from meetings being held across the diocese with randomly selected groups during May.

A summary document will be forwarded from our diocese at the end of May.

Update on Turkwel Security Fence

When we reported in January, we had just given Sr. Consolata the go ahead to start work on the 650-metre security fence to enclose the health clinic and maternity unit site in Kalemanyung, Turkwel. She replied that the Kalemanyung community had donated additional land to the clinic, so 30% additional fencing would be needed. Thanks to your continued generosity, we were able to confirm that we could cover the additional cost.

The revised quotation for the extended fence is €20,120. We have already transferred €7,178 to the account in Turkwel for the purchase of materials and will shortly make a further interim payment. Once the work is completed and accounts finalised, we will publish a full financial report.

Rains prevented the transportation of materials until late April, so work only began this week.
