John 16:12-15

THE HEART OF OUR GOD

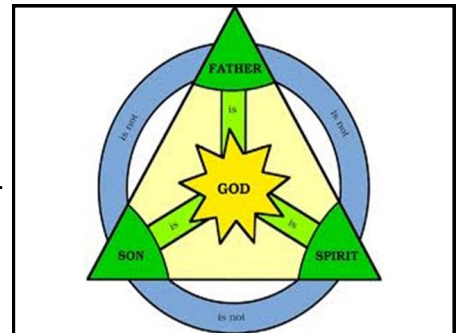
Jesus puts it very clearly when He tells His disciples to baptise in the name of the Father, of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Jesus is highlighting that God is a community of love, that we call Trinity for want of a better name. God is a set of three relationships of love, of distinct but intertwining loves that always was, is now and always will be. Jesus is giving us a first glimpse of who God is in His heart of hearts. It is something we could never have discovered ourselves if Jesus had not told us. To believe in the Trinity is a pure gift of God.

True, God is the creator of all things. One of the first astronauts to see planet Earth from outer space exclaimed his praise and wonder of the Creator. The splendour of mountain, lake and sea, of flowers, trees, birds and every living creature alerts us to the wonder of God's creation and are reminders of all His gifts to us.

But God is more than all His achievements and His gifts. God is love, three persons perfectly loving and perfectly loveable. We struggle to analyse it and understand fully the mystery of three distinct persons that are our God.

There is the pitfall. We concentrate on understanding and evaluating. The focus must be on appreciation of the wonder of who God is, who lives within us, in whose image we are made, and in whose love we share intimately as His children.

Realising how securely loved we are, can motivate us to live joyfully in unconditional love for one another. Actions speak louder than words. Our lifestyle of respect for others, of generosity, forgiveness, leadership in service, can inspire and deepen trust in God among all who share this planet with us.
