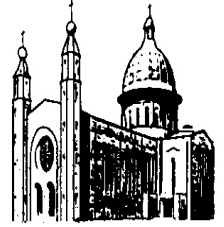

TRANSFORMING PARISHES TOGETHER INTO MISSION - CENTRED FAITH COMMUNITIES

Bishop Fintan Gavin, Bishop of Cork and Ross, has published a pastoral letter which outlines the context and vision for changes being made this summer.

The pastoral letter entitled “*Putting out into Deep Waters*” introduces a new model for the relationship between parishes and a new emphasis on teams of Priests, Deacons and Lay People ministering together in families of parishes.

“Families of Parishes” present a real opportunity for much greater lay participation in the leadership of parishes and will allow a much greater co-ordination in the preparation and the celebration of sacraments.

“Families of Parishes” will give the people of Cork and Ross an opportunity to work together, united for mission, enhancing our own strengths collaboratively to build up our local Church.
