# Your good works

You may notice we have begun publishing our Collection figures every week: Offertory and Shrines. We make the distinction because we are taxed at the rate of 18% on the Offertory figures; 10% for Diocesan administration and 8% to support sick and retired priests who are not in receipt of a stipend. Our priest stipends come from the Autumn and Spring Dues and two Church Collections; Christmas and Easter. All the other Collections maintain our parish. In recent years we have been paying out more than we take in; COVID had something to do with this. Every parish received some COVID compensation recently. What has also helped is the Revenue returns from the annual contribution using the Offering Envelope.

With the help of our Finance Committee, we use your contributions as wisely and as carefully as we can, we don't obsess over money, we look at everything step by step. Our regular outgoings include the annual insurance for all church property, heat and light (priests pay their own), building maintenance and wages (not for priests). Our more recent outgoings are for roof leaks, new railings and refurbishing of the Parish Office and Meeting Room. We will be submitting our Annual Report shortly and will publish it in the church.

Each priest looks after his own expenses although the physical maintenance of each house is the responsibility of the parish; again these figures are published.

We thrive and flourish, not just financially, through your good works. Your presence in our church gives life and hope to all our efforts. Your prayers for us strengthen our resolve to proclaim the Good News. In this way, finances, though necessary, do not become a worry or an obsession, but simply a means of maintaining the heart and soul of our parish without too much burden.
