My friend, Fr Criostoir MacDonald, used to read our bulletins online and always had a comment on what I might say. He was always very positive, even when he was criticising, so I am thinking of him as I write this now. His sudden death last week was a great shock and many of us began making our own, rather sober, plans for our funerals. We know neither the day nor the hour. From what I can gather, he was never in such good form as in the days before his death, during our Retreat and on that first day of the pilgrimage to Rome that was leading. So, that alone is a comfort.

We will shortly be commemorating our dead, and with it, the time will change too, an hour going back, making our evenings darker. No wonder we think of darker things! Between the scary stuff at shop windows and people's front doors and lawns, Trick or Treating, blessing of graves, listing of our dead, we have a strange mix of feelings. Dia de Los Santos and Dia de Los Muertos, All Saints Day and All Souls Day, follow each other. In a different time, we thought of simpler things, barm brack, bobbing apples, the Novena. We took the days as we found them. Whatever time we live in, the past or present, we all share the same concerns and fears on both life and death.

Love God...love your neighbour, the message of the gospel this weekend, is an age old message for every time.

Happy homecoming to Criostoir and all our dead.
