Shalom

We are coming towards the 'final things', theme of the latter Sundays of the Church's year before the season of Advent will usher in the 'new beginnings' of the year to come. You will see this evident this weekend when the 'great upheaval' before judgement day is explored. In the light of this I want to talk to you in this message of a Catholic media group which explores the human need for direction, truth and peace in our human hearts and in our Church.

Around this time, back in 2017, I took a seven week break, joining a sabbatical course with the Redemptorists in St Mary's Monastery just outside the city of Perth in Scotland. Many other priests and sisters have taken part; there were twenty others with me. It renewed us in the study we followed all those years ago when we were preparing for ordination. Towards the end of that time, just as Advent was beginning, a film crew arrived; part of a series they were making on Advent and focussed on us for a few days. You can just see the back of my head in one of the sequences. The film crew were from Shalom World UK. Its purpose is to evangelise us once more, encouraging us in faith, in the ways of peace and holiness. It is headquartered in Texas, USA, with production centres in Canada, UK, India, Austria, Australia and here in Ireland. There is a strong presence here in Cork and Shalom ministry has been involved here in Dennehy's Cross with some of our parishioners helping in their productions. It began as a small prayer group in 1989. It combats the corruption and lack of faith presence in much of modern media, to restore all things in Christ and lead us back to God.

Shalom World is a media apostolate based in Portlaoise, Co. Laois, which actively supports the evangelisation efforts of the Church by disseminating the Gospel through its various media initiatives. Bishop Denis Nulty is the patron of Shalom Media in Ireland. Adhering to the teachings of the Catholic Church, Shalom World believes in the transformative power of media to spread God's love, peace and truth, to every corner of the globe.
