From within

Many of you will know a little of the Faith in Action group formed within our parish some years ago. Its purpose was to bring alive people's faith by visible action for our times, combining spiritual, educational and social justice themes. A simple list of yearly activities alone will explore the depth of their presence within this parish.

The Pentecost Novena, prayed every morning at the beginning of our church's Festival. A new format for Stations of the Cross to be made available to people during this coming Lent.

The Lenten Talks on Tuesday nights, well attended, on climate change and social justice. The Annual Fairtrade Coffee Morning coupled with an exhibition of Fairtrade products available.

Links were developed with our Sister Parish in Turkwel, Kenya through prayer offered at every Thursday Mass, and through financial aid. The last major project was the building of a Maternity Unit which cost €95,000. It was built and open within a year. Seed Sunday is organised every Spring, when free seeds of vegetables, herbs, fruit and flowers are distributed to promote home production. The results are shared at the Harvest Festival Creation Mass.

The children in Direct Provision in Cork receive annual Santa gifts, courtesy of our parishioners' generosity ; 34 children this year.

Ballineaspag parish was the first in the diocese to receive an Eco Congregation Award in relation to its work for ecological justice in 2015, and a Gold Award in 2020.

The parish has hosted the Eco Justice Candle several times; an occasion to pray for and raise awareness for the future of our world.

The Faith in Action group meets on the first Tuesday of every month in the Parish Room at 7.30pm. If you feel attracted to this kind of work, you would be very welcome to 'come and see'.
