News from the Diocese of supporting ministries:

This week we outline some of the Diocesan ministries in which we hope to take part this year. We are optimistic that a number of our young parishioners are getting more involved in their faith and have indicated their interest. With that in mind, I am hoping to meet up with them shortly with a view to linking them with the ministries outlined below.

Gathering for Diocesan Alpha teams: The Office of Mission and Ministry will host a Diocesan Alpha Team Day on **Saturday, 26th September** from 10.00am to 3.00pm in Mardyke House. As we begin a new year of Alpha, this will be an opportunity for teams from across the Diocese to come together for prayer, encouragement and conversation. We will share experiences, learn from one another and explore some of the key principles that help alpha to flourish. Gerard Hanley from Alpha Ireland will join us, bringing his experience and insights and helping us reflect on how we can strengthen Alpha in our Parishes. The day is open to both new and experienced Alpha team members. Please contact Lorraine in the Office for Mission and Ministry to register.

Alpha Youth: Alpha Youth continues to be an effective way of connecting young people with their local Parish. Through collaboration between schools and Parish volunteers, young people are invited to explore faith in a welcoming and engaging environment. As students complete Alpha Youth, Parishes are encouraged to build on these relationships by establishing Parish-based youth groups, providing opportunities for teenagers to continue growing in faith, friendship and involvement in Parish life. This initiative is now taking place in a growing number of parishes across the diocese.

Formation in Faith: Formation in Faith is a 9 week programme for young adults beginning on Wednesday, **30th September 2026** from 5.45pm to 8.00pm in Mardyke House, Cork. Participants can choose between two pathways: Sycamore, a video based faith formation series with group discussion, or Foundations in theology, a lecture based introduction to Catholic theology with local guest speakers. Each evening begins with food and refreshments and provides participants with an opportunity to engage in meaningful discussion.
